Dear PIA Members,

Another winter has gone by and we hope we have seen the last snow fall for the season, fingers crossed. The island is slowly waking up and becoming more active. PIA FINANCIAL REPORT JANUARY 2016 – DECEMBER 2016

Bingo ended the year with a bank balance of \$4,985. The game income for the season was \$12,967 and the prize payout was \$10,651. Bingo donated \$13,000 to the PIA for the Roof Project.

The PYO ended the year with a bank balance of \$3,515. The Snack Shack had an income of \$3,508 and the Craft Fair brought in \$290. Expenses for the Snack Shack in 2016 came to \$1,803. The two-day winter trip cost \$3,024 and the summer trip \$497.

The PIA bank balance at the end of 2016 was \$26,593. Below are highlights for both PIA income and expenses in 2016.


